

## **SAFETY NOTIFICATION TO WORKERS IN PROUD TEXTILE**

(Address: Plot # 31/A, BSCIC I/E, Narayanganj)

Date: 6<sup>th</sup> February 2018

The Accord is a legal agreement between international garment brands and unions that represent workers. The purpose of the Accord is to protect the safety of garment workers by inspecting factory buildings, identifying risks to worker safety, and making sure that factory owners eliminate these risks by renovating and repairing the buildings.

The Accord inspected Proud Textile for fire, electrical and structural safety in the period 8<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> February 2015 and found a number of problems that could cause serious harm to workers. The Accord has asked Proud Textile to make changes to eliminate these risks. Unfortunately, Proud Textile has failed to:

- Complete the installation of a fire alarm system. This could result in workers not being warned that there is a fire.
- Install a fire sprinkler system. This could result in not discharging water when there is a fire incident.
- Complete fire separation in the relevant areas. This could result in workers becoming stuck on the higher floors of the building if there is a fire.
- Safely install and maintain electrical equipment and fix up electrical wiring. This could create serious electrical hazards in the factory which might lead to fire incidents.
- Fix the problems with the building structure. This could result in the failure of the structure and injuries to workers.

The Accord has made many efforts to get the owners of Proud Textile to fix these safety hazards, so that workers will be safe, but the owners have refused to do so.

As a result, Proud Textile is unsafe for workers. Because of this, the brands that have signed the Accord will no longer do business with Proud Textile and will no longer place any orders at the factory. The Accord wants to make sure that all workers at Proud Textile are aware that the building is not safe.

If workers choose not to work at Proud Textile because of these safety risks, or if Proud Textile, the brands that have signed the Accord will make an effort to help workers find



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jobs at nearby factories that are safe. There is no guarantee that a job will be available, but the brands will try to assist.
