## **SAFETY NOTIFICATION TO WORKERS IN FASHION STORE LTD.**

Address: 81 Kalmessar, Bldg 01, Board Bazar, Gazipur.

The Accord is a legal agreement between international garment brands and unions that represent workers. The purpose of the Accord is to protect the safety of garment workers by inspecting factory buildings, identifying risks to worker safety, and making sure that factory owners eliminate these risks by renovating and repairing the buildings.

The Accord has conducted an inspection of Fashion Store Ltd. on 20 May 2014 and found a number of problems that could cause serious harm to workers. The Accord has asked Fashion Store Ltd. to make changes to eliminate these risks. Unfortunately, Fashion Store Ltd. has failed to:

- Remove locking features or render them inoperable from the egress doors/gates. This could result in workers being locked in the factory during a fire or another emergency.
- Remove collapsible gates/sliding doors/rolling shutters. This could be an obstacle for workers during evacuation in case of fire incident or another emergency.
- Ensure that the exits are free of storage or other obstacles. This could result in workers becoming stuck while there is a fire.
- Complete fire separation in the relevant areas. This could result in workers becoming stuck on the higher floors of the building if there is a fire.
- Safely install and maintain electrical equipment and fix up electrical wiring. This could create serious electrical hazards in the factory which might lead to fire incidents.

The Accord has made many efforts to get the owners of Fashion Store Ltd. to fix these safety hazards, so that workers will be safe, but the owners have refused to do so.

As a result, Fashion Store Ltd. is unsafe for workers. Because of this, the brands that have signed the Accord will no longer do business with Fashion Store Ltd. and will no longer place any orders at the factory. The Accord wants to make sure that all workers at Fashion Store Ltd. are aware that the building is not safe.

If workers choose not to work at Fashion Store Ltd. because of these safety risks, or if Fashion Store Ltd. closes, the brands that have signed the Accord will make an effort to help workers find jobs at nearby factories that are safe. There is no guarantee that a job will be available, but the brands will try to assist.
